The endowment pool's purpose is to maintain the purchasing power of the underlying endowments in perpetuity with additional emphasis on portfolio growth.


#### Positioning

U.S. Consumer Confidence Index



The consumer remains the leading driver of the US economy, accounting for nearly two-thirds of economic activity. Consumer confidence has recovered sharply after months of lockdowns and depressed spending. The Consumer Confidence Index recently produced its highest reading since the pandemic began, displaying consumers' willingness to spend. Retail sales have recovered to pre-pandemic levels even as savings rates increased as a result of pent-up demand and multiple rounds of stimulus checks. Cash in money markets accounts still sits near record highs of \$4.5 trillion.
